EWB U of T x B2P Present: Water Systems in Tanzania

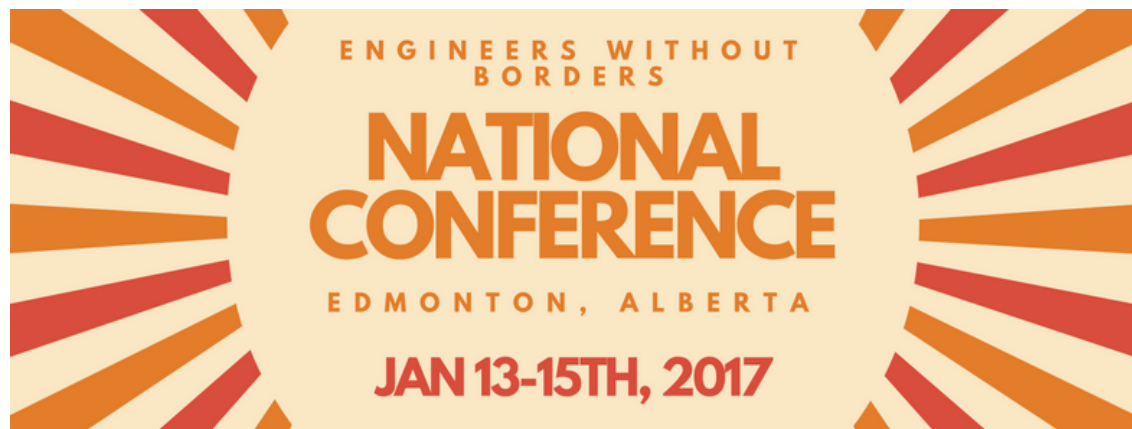
